A UN resolution established the International Day of Peace in 1981. Since 2002 Sept 21 has been designated as the official International Day of Peace. The assembly also declared that the day should be observed as a day of global ceasefire, cessation of hostilities and non-violence. People are encouraged to commemorate and celebrate this day through education and public awareness on issues related to Peace. Since then it has grown to include millions of people worldwide and many other events are organized each year. For the past 14 years civil groups had actively commemorated the IDP Day with festive and meaningful activities. Last year the Minister of National Unity and Social Well Being, YB. Senator Waytha Moorthy and the UNDP Resident Representative graced our evening commemoration program at the PLS Peace Park attended by over 500.
